The *Proceedings*, published since 1974, has now moved to a primarily online format with the Scholarly Publishing Office at the University of Michigan Library. Volumes 31-37 (Newport Beach [2003], Lubbock [2004], Colorado Springs [2005], Long Beach [2006], Albuquerque [2007], Quebec [2008], Boulder [2009], and La Fayette [2010]) are available at <http://quod.lib.umich.edu/w/wsfh/>. The *Proceedings* are indexed in *Historical Abstracts*; *America: History and Life*; *PapersFirst*; and *ProceedingsFirst*. With the *Proceedings* available online and for free, we hope that our readership will increase significantly. Please remind your university library to link the *Proceedings* site to its catalog.

Authors: We invite participants of the Portland meeting of the WSFH to submit revised versions of their papers for publication in the *Proceedings of the Western Society for French History*. The *Proceedings* are peer reviewed in a process that involves: 1) recommendations by panel chairs and commentators about a paper's suitability for publication, and 2) the judgment of the editors and recommendations from an editorial board.

Deadline for submission is **15 January 2012**. Papers may be submitted electronically or by post. All submissions coming through the mail must include both a hard copy of the paper and a computer disk with the paper in Word 6.0 or higher.
